Scholarship Applicant Selection Guidelines

Applications will be accepted from September 1st through the second week in December.

- 1. Application is to be completed by the athlete (not the parents).
- 2. Use of scholarship dollars are prioritized:
 - a) Registration to participate in a racing program
 - b) Travel to race events in US or Europe
 - c) Equipment
- 3. Parental income (between both parents).
- 4. Number of siblings (are they in a race program?)
- 5. Signed release to use name and photo as part of application.
- 6. Agreement to provide accountability to verify dollars were spent for requested use.

THE BILL McCOLLOM ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP

In addition to two scholarship awards of \$1,500 the New England Master's Foundation will also award a \$2,000 scholarship in the name of Bill McCollom.

Bill was a writer, school administrator, teacher, coach, and so much more. Viewing his life as a series of new adventures, he was a man of perpetual motion, a fixture at local ski mountains, tennis courts, bike trails, on theater stages, and in various local organizations. Each of these activities became his community and he welcomed all to join him.

Bill's contributions to skiing are too many and too diverse to adequately list, but include skiing at Holderness School, racing as an all-American for Middlebury College in the 1960s, competing in the 1967 World Cup downhill at Cannon Mountain, coaching at Harvard, serving as Headmaster at the Killington Mountain School, serving as a ski racing journalist, and maintaining an editorial column in Ski Racing Magazine called "The Finish Line".

Beyond the many successes one could point to, Bill will be remembered by his friends and competitors as an ambassador for the sport he loved so much. He had a clear passion for skiing, and pulled as many people as he could into its community.
